She was born in West Africa, sold into slavery and transported to Boston when she was 7 or 8, purchased by the Wheatley family, who taught her to read and encouraged her talent for writing.

She wrote Poems on Various Subjects, Religious and Moral, making her the first African American and first slave to publish a volume of poetry. Phillis Wheatley - Slave Poet of Colonial America The American Revolution intervened in Phillis Wheatley's career, and the effect was not completely positive. The people of Boston -- and of America and England -- bought books on other topics rather than the volume of Phillis Wheatley poems.
